Hospitality budget will be reduced from \$1,000 to \$800, canceling breakfast at the barn and costs Skating party reduced to \$0, canceling, due to safety concerns/parent availability during the day Spirit Wear, \$500, reduced, buffer in budget if merch doesn't sale, have not needed it in 3 years Stripe Fees, \$3500, over budget this year, will continue to increase as we use online payments Staff Appreciation Budget, needed to increase \$3200, this year, and will remain increased Supplemental; Contracts, (intramurals/choir) \$1600, reduced, haven't used more than \$1500 in past 3 years

Multicultural Night, \$800 needed increase this year to supplement food, will remain increased Wellness Committee/walking Club \$1000, requested increase to revamp charms and do another event for wellness

PTO vote approved increase TOTAL FUNDS BUDGET to \$47,000 All members present voted yes to approve these changes.
