4. Treasurer's Report – Amber Allen + Sarah Barker - ***Reimbursement Deadline June 10, 2024***

Requests for funds for this year,

Multicultural, requests to increase budget to \$800 instead of current \$500 for this year and in the future (Amanda motioned to move funds from FFFN. Mandy seconded). All voted to approve \$300 from FFFN fund.

Field day requests \$700 additional to the current \$300. (Amanda motioned to approve to move funds from spirit wear. Mandy seconded the motion). All voted to approve \$700 from spirit wear funds

Staff appreciation budget to \$825. (Mandy motioned to move funds from the Community Fund. Amanda seconded.) All voted to approve \$825 from Community Funds.

5. Principals Report – Jason Wulf-

Choir will be performed at 7pm on 3/20 at Greensview.

Early release at 1pm for 4/8.

Mrs. Campbell is working with CBJ for a field trip to explore Nationwide arena 4/10 (More information to follow).

Also, Mr. Wulf received a quote to soundproof the gym (like the cafeteria). Based on the building structure estimate is about \$35,000 for the project with basic design; to add color or design it is about \$20/square foot and would be more expensive. This could be a gift from PTO from long term savings.

6. Committee Reports

- a. Consumer Earnings Recap - Regan Bohnert- (Berwick 2/29) \$307 of 10% of sales. Currently working with one of Greensview parents who owns an ice cream shop for ice cream night for Greensview. Possible date on UA baseball opening, will have updates in next meeting

- b. Mane Event Recap - Jennifer Drew + Megan Amstutz- 121 general admission, 20 sponsorships, and 4 teachers. Attendants have generally positive feedback regarding the event. Possible improvement for next year: less seated tables, more high tops tables allowing more room to move around and more gambling tables for entertainment. Need to shorten wait times for alcoholic drinks, and add tents to help increase capacity. Silent auction \$14,000 (goal of \$13,000). The after party at the Fairway (\$820). Alcohol sales from Mane event: \$2600 revenue (cost was \$530), most alcohol are from individual donations. All class artworks sold this year! Teacher donations received more bidders than in past years. This year, they exceeded their target goal by \$9000.
- c. Multicultural Night - 4/26 - Kavitha Plowgian Kotha + JD Boyle- UA library will set up a station for activities to interact with kids. Mrs. Auseon will have a pop up choir to kick off the event. Still looking for participants for the multicultural talent show. Will be asking for middle school volunteers after spring break. Use the 300-400 dollars in the budget to purchase food for the event to ensure there will be enough food served.
